 - Share Simba's name with the crowd.
 - Announce that Simba is next in line for the throne.
 - Share what kind of leader you hope Simba will be.

- 5. Rehearse this scene several times. Challenge yourself to stay in character, listen, and react to Mufasa's speech without pulling the focus away from Mufasa.
