#### PRIDE A ANSWERS:

- <u>3</u> Get into costume and makeup.
- <u>8</u> Make first entrance onto the stage.
- **2** Warm up body and voice.
- <u>4</u> Recieve microphone.
- <u>7</u> Take places backstage.
- <u>5</u> Sound check.
- <u>1</u> Sign in at the callboard.
- **6** Confirm that all props are pre-set backstage.

#### PRIDE B ANSWERS: 🚄

- <u>8</u> Ushers check restrooms and lobby space to make sure everyone is in the house before show begins.
- 6 House manager flashes lights in the house to notify audience that the show is about to begin.
- <u>4</u> Ushers tear or scan tickets.
- **10** Ushers greet late arrivals and seat them at established late seating moments.
- <u>3</u> House manager opens the house (typically 30 minutes prior to curtain).
- <u>5</u> House manager recieves a "5 minutes" cue from stage manager.
- **2** House manager "gets the house" from stage management, meaning all actors are backstage and audience can be brought into the house.
- <u>7</u> House manager recieves a "places" cue from stage management.
- <u>1</u> House manager opens theater lobbies to public.
- 9 House manager lets stage manager know when all audience members are in the house.

## PRIDE WORK ANSWER KEY (CONTINUED)

### PRIDE CANSWERS:

- <u>1</u> Stage manager checks that all actors have arrived.
- <u>5</u> Stage manager lets house manager know that he can open house.
- <u>7</u> Stage manager gives house management "5 minute" to show time cue.
- <u>9</u> Light board operator dims house light.
- **2** Wardrobe department checks that all costumes are preset for the top of the show.
- <u>3</u> Crew makes sure all set pieces are in working order and set for top of show.
- **<u>6</u>** Stage manager gives actors "5 minute" to show time cue.
- **10** Light board operator executes first lighting cue.
- <u>8</u> Stage management lets house management know actors and crew are in "places."
- <u>4</u> Prop department presets props for top of show.
